Job Description & Key Responsibilities

As a data collector, you will

- Actively participate and complete training;
- Test the survey instruments and the sampling strategy in the field;
- Conduct interviews in the field following the survey instruments;
- Perform duties as allocated by your supervisor;
- Document issues that arise in the field and communicate them to your supervisor;
- Take responsibility for tracking expenses and reporting them to your supervisor;
- Assist in any other tasks related to the delivery of the project at hand as assigned by your supervisor.

As a transcriber, you will

- Transcribing word-by-word the content of the recorded interviews;
- Correctly formatting the transcribed text as instructed;
- Responding in a timely manner to the feedback from reviews of submitted work;
- Communicating to DM any issue that would lead to not meeting the assigned deadline;
- Acting in a professional and honest manner and serving as example to fellow team members;
- Assisting in any other tasks related to the delivery of the project at hand.
- Demonstrate availability and presence to perform the services required.

As translator, you will

- Translating the interview from the source to the target language;
- Anonymizing the translated document by replacing the names by initials (first letter of each name), and using the initials used before where one name is used to refer to the person whose names were mentioned earlier for consistency;
- Clarifying terms and concepts that would otherwise remain ambiguous or decontextualized;
- Conceptualizing the language in order to avoid misinterpretation, misunderstanding and loss of the intended meaning:
- Communicating to Senior Field Supervisor any issue that would lead to not meeting the assigned deadline;
- Acting in a professional and honest manner and serving as example to fellow team members;
- Assisting in any other tasks related to the delivery of the project at hand.

Ideal candidates have experience in collecting quantitative data using electronic data collection instruments, are excellent communicators in English and Kinyarwanda, and have a minimum of a bachelor's degree in any field or currently enrolled in a university. Fluency in speaking other languages (e.g. French, Swahili...etc) is a plus. We strongly encourage individuals with field supervision experience to apply.
