This role combines research design, data analysis, project management support, and fieldwork coordination in a collaborative and fast-paced environment.

WHO WE ARE

Our project portfolio in Kenya is varied and ranges from data collection (including mixed-methods studies) to full-cycle research projects. The Kenya team works across all our key sectors with the majority of projects in education, public health and agriculture topics. Our team in Nairobi currently consists of 14 team members.

- Work closely with field teams to resolve data quality issues.
- Support statistical analysis and interpretation of findings.
- Contribute to consultancy-quality reports and data-driven insights.

- At least one year of professional experience in similar roles or tasks. (We welcome experience gained through internships, dissertation work, or participation in an academic research group, provided you can demonstrate how this experience meets the requirements of the role.)
- Strong quantitative data analysis skills and proficiency in Stata.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in English.

- Experience working with ODK-based platforms (e.g., SurveyCTO).
- Previous work experience in Kenya.
- Organizational and interpersonal skills, self-motivation and drive to work in a collaborative environment.
